



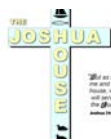
### Haiti

- φ Haiti means "mountainous country", three quarters of its 10,714 acres is mountainous.
- φ The official language of Haiti is French and Creole
- φ Haiti is the second largest island in the Caribbean which it shares with the Spanish speaking Dominican Republic.
- φ Haiti is approximately 80% Catholic, 16% Protestant (Baptist 10%), 4% Pentecostal 4%, 1% Adventist and 1% other.
- φ The capital of Haiti is Port-au-Prince which is 5 times larger than the next biggest city, Cap Haitian.
- φ Haiti is one of the most densely populated countries in the world.
- φ A tectonic fault line runs through the country, causing earthquakes.
- φ Haiti is located within the Caribbean hurricane belt.
- φ Haiti is the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere and one of the poorest in the world

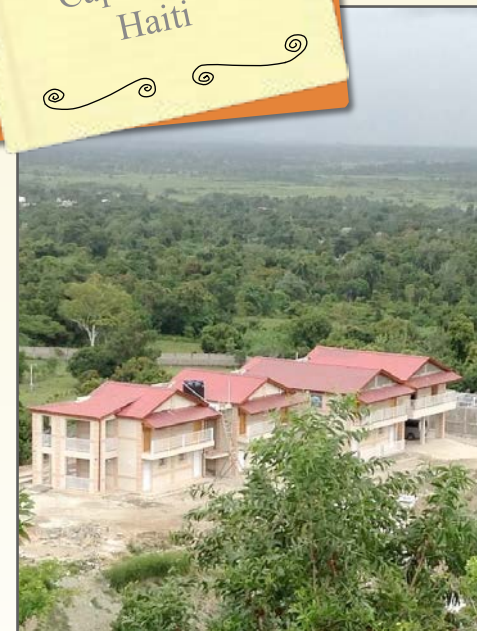

## Joshua House Details

### ◆Houses up to 34 people

- 1 rooms fit 2 people (Queen Bed)
- 4 rooms fit 3/4 people each
- 3 rooms fit 6 people each

### ◆Amenities include

- Generator for power
- Bathroom with shower in each bedroom
- Kitchen with stove and refrigerator
- Safe drinking water
- Fans, Linens (sheets and towels)
- Host couple to help if needed

### ◆Cost per person (as of 8.29.2013)

Cost per person per week = \$350

### ◆Cost includes

- Room with all amenities
- Transportation to and from airport
- Transportation to and from local work sites
- Food for 3 meals/day
- Security
- Team support from the Haitian Team
- Note: excursions\* may cost extra

### ◆Payment Requirements

- \$175/person deposit with reservation
- Full payment 120 days prior to arrival

### ◆Work Site Options

- Projects on grounds at IDADEE
- Work with children at IDADEE
- Project in community around IDADEE
- Project at EBAC
- Work with children at EBAC
- Work "beyond the walls" in the community

### \*Excursion Options

- Citadel, tourist market, beach, meal in town,
- church in town, recycling project with Thread

## Travel Details/Decisions

There are two options to fly into and out of Hugo Chavez International Airport in Cap Haitian, Haiti:

### ◆Missionary Flights International

- Flies out of Ft. Pearce, FL
- Least expensive travel option
- Personal touch
- Cost as of August 29, 2013 is \$450/person
- Cost includes \$60 departure fee
- May require overnight stay in FL
- Luggage limit: 50#/person
- Overage charge: \$1.50/#

### ◆IBC Airways

- Flights out varies
- Personal touch
- Cost is variable
- Luggage limit (unknown)
- Cost of \$60/person departure fee not included-  
*must be paid in cash before leaving*

### ◆Items Worth Mentioning

- Please stay in constant communications with Joshua House to insure coordination of schedules and drivers.

- It may be necessary to stay overnight at a hotel prior to leaving for Haiti and upon your return in order to make plane connections.

- Cost as shown in this brochure DOES NOT necessarily include any service project cost. Please communicate with Joshua House about the project and associated costs.

-As to service projects, preference is to purchase items in Haiti but the availability is not consistent. Any supplies taken from the states will incur charge from the airlines and at customs in Haiti.
